Special Notice

The Bar's By-Laws <u>prohibit</u> the rendering of opinions in the following situations:

- 1. Where questions of law are involved;
- 2. When the ethics or conduct of a lawyer in a matter in which such conduct is involved in pending litigation, which may determine or substantially affect the determination of the ethical question involved; or,
- 3. Where past conduct is involved.

In addition, §73-3-143 (2), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated and Amended, provides that an advisory opinion can be rendered concerning the validity or propriety of <u>any proposed act or course of conduct</u>.

In considering a request before it, the Committee may determine the ethics opinion would be beneficial to the Bar as a whole and ask the Board of Bar Commissioners to issue a Formal Interpretive Opinion. All Formal Interpretative Opinions (F.I.O.) must be approved and adopted by the Board of Bar Commissioners of The Mississippi Bar. As a result, it may take longer than 90 days to issue a Formal Interpretative Opinion.

The Committee may also choose to issue an Informal Advisory Opinion unique to the question posed. Informal Advisory Opinions remain unpublished.

Please note that in accordance with the Rules of the Ethics Committee, the Committee may in its discretion decline to render an opinion regarding any matter which is currently the subject of any litigation, civil or criminal or a disciplinary proceeding.
