INTRODUCTION

The 2010 Mississippi Bar Economic Survey was administered electronically in October, 2010. The previous economic surveys, performed every two years, were mailed to a randomly selected sample of Bar members representing approximately one-third of the membership. In an effort to expand participation and enhance the accuracy of the information obtained, the survey was made available to all Bar members through a link emailed to them. As with all new processes, there were some unanticipated issues involving the entry of data and the ability to skip some questions. These were addressed and noted for future surveys, and did not affect the integrity of the survey results as a whole.

The questions for the survey were suggested by the Mississippi Bar. All technology questions included in previous surveys were eliminated. The accounting firm of Grantham Poole was responsible for the administration and tabulation of the survey and its results.


A total of 817 members responded to the survey representing a participation rate of 13%. Of the responses received, the largest percentages were from Hinds county (31%), Madison county (13%) and Harrison county (8%). Although a full third of the responders had practiced 26 years or more, the survey does represent all levels of experience with answers being spread fairly equally amount the age groups. Other general characteristics noted in the results included the following:

- 74% of the respondents were male
- 95% of the respondents were Caucasian
- 94% of the respondents work full-time in the practice of law
- 57% graduated from the University of Mississippi School of Law; 26% graduated from the Mississippi College School of Law; 17% received their law degrees from other institutions


The charts that follow illustrate the answers to questions relating to firm structure and size, income and salaries, hourly rates and billable hours, marketing and personal satisfaction with the profession.


WHAT IS YOUR TYPE OF EMPLOYMENT?




WHAT IS THE STRUCTURE OF YOUR FIRM?



WHAT IS THE SIZE OF YOUR FIRM?




HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN A LICENSED ATTORNEY?



2010 Secretary Annual Compensation by Experience




Secretary Compensation by Size of Firm Sole Practictioner



Secretary Compensation by Size of Firm 2-3 Attorneys




Secretary Compensation by Size of Firm 4-5 Attorneys



Secretary Compensation by Size of Firm 6-10 Attorneys




Secretary Compensation by Size of Firm 11-19 Attorneys





Secretary Compensation by Size of Firm 20+ Attorneys




COMPENSATION FOR LEGAL ASSISTANTS IN 2010

2010 Paralegal Annual Compensation by Experience




Paralegal Compensation by Size of Firm Sole Practicioner



Paralegal Compensation by Size of Firm 2-3 Attorneys




Paralegal Compensation by Size of Firm 4-5 Attorneys



Paralegal Compensation by Size of Firm 6-10 Attorneys




Paralegal Compensation by Size of Firm 11-19 Attorneys







2010 Associate Annual Compensation by Experience




Associate Compensation by Size of Firm 2-3 Attorneys






Associate Compensation by Size of Firm 6-10 Attorneys



Associate Compensation by Size of Firm 11-19 Attorneys




Associate Compensation by Size of Firm 20+ Attorneys




PERSONAL ANNUAL INCOME FROM PRACTICING LAW IN 2009


Annual Income By Firm Size




WHEN YOU CHARGE ON AN HOURLY BASIS, WHAT IS YOUR STANDARD HOURLY RATE?




HOW MANY BILLABLE HOURS DO YOU HAVE PER YEAR? (On Average)




WHAT TYPES OF ADVERTISING /MARKETING DO YOU OR YOUR FIRM USE?






IN THE PAST FIVE YEARS, DO YOU THINK THAT THE PROFESSIONALISM AMONG LAWYERS HAS......




DO YOU GET ANY PERSONAL SATISFACTION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW?




IN AN AVERAGE MONTH, HOW MANY HOURS DO YOU SPEND ON CIVIC AND COMMUNITY WORK?




